

# Anmac National Nursing Forum Scholarship 2026

## Terms and Conditions

### Overview

These Terms and Conditions apply to recipients of the National Nursing Forum (NNF) Scholarship, supporting overseas-born nurses to attend the NNF in Melbourne on 6–7 August 2026.

Acceptance of the scholarship constitutes agreement to these terms.

### Scholarship Inclusions:

Successful recipients will receive:

- Full conference registration to the NNF
- Return domestic travel within Australia (booked by Anmac)
- Two (2) nights' accommodation in Melbourne (extended dates determined by Anmac)
- Attendance at an Anmac-hosted networking breakfast

All inclusions are non-transferable and cannot be exchanged for cash or alternative items.

### Travel Arrangements

- Travel will be arranged by Anmac or its nominated provider – Corporate Traveller. Travel arrangements will be determined by Anmac based on operational and budget considerations.
- Travel is limited to economy class within Australia only.
- Travel will be to and from usual place of residence.
- Travel bookings will include checked-in baggage.
- Departure and return dates will align with conference attendance requirements.
- Recipients are responsible for:
  - Travel to and from their nearest departure airport
  - Personal expenses incurred during travel (e.g. incidentals)
  - Changes to travel arrangements requested by the recipient may not be accommodated and, if approved, may be at the recipient's own cost.
- A taxi voucher will be provided to all recipients for use between the destination airport and the booked accommodation or conference venue.

### Accommodation

- Accommodation will be arranged and paid for by Anmac for two nights. Additional nights' accommodation may be provided depending on flight schedules and travel requirements.
- Hotel selection will be at Anmac's discretion and will be within walking distance to the conference.
- Rooms are provided on a single-occupancy basis unless otherwise specified.
- Recipients are responsible for:
  - Incidentals (e.g. minibar, room service, laundry)
  - Any additional nights or upgrades requested

### Meals

- Breakfast is included with the accommodation.
- Lunch will be provided at the conference.
- A Gala Dinner will be held on the first evening of the conference.
- Anmac will reimburse the cost of one additional dinner up to a maximum value of \$50 upon submission of a valid tax invoice or receipt.

## Attendance Requirements

Recipients must:

- Attend the full National Nursing Forum program (6–7 August 2026)
- Attend the Anmac networking breakfast on 6 August 2026.

Failure to attend scheduled scholarship activities without reasonable cause may result in:

- withdrawal of scholarship benefits
- cancellation of future travel or accommodation arrangements
- reimbursement of costs already incurred, at Anmac's discretion

## Recipient Responsibilities

Recipients agree to:

- Provide accurate information in their application
- Be available for the full duration of the conference
- Conduct themselves professionally and respectfully throughout all scholarship and conference-related activities
  - Conference codes of conduct
  - Workplace professional standards
- Recipients may be invited (but not obligated) to:
  - Provide feedback on their experience
  - Participate in promotional, communications or reporting activities (e.g. testimonials or social media content), subject to consent.

## Changes, Withdrawals and Cancellations

If a recipient is unable to attend, they must notify Anmac as soon as possible.

Anmac reserves the right to:

- Reallocate the scholarship to another applicant
- Recover costs already incurred, where cancellation is late or without valid reason
- Circumstances beyond the recipient's control will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

## Conference Changes or Cancellation

If the National Nursing Forum is cancelled, postponed or materially changed, Anmac reserves the right to amend, defer or withdraw scholarship inclusions where necessary.

Anmac will not be responsible for costs incurred independently by recipients outside approved scholarship arrangements.

## Insurance and Liability

Recipients are responsible for ensuring their own personal and travel insurance if desired.

Anmac is not responsible for:

- Personal injury
- Loss or damage to personal belongings
- Delays or disruptions beyond its control.

## Privacy and Use of Information

Personal information collected will be used for:

- Scholarship assessment and administration
- Event coordination
- Personal information will be handled in accordance with the Australian Privacy Principles (APPs).
- Recipients' names may be published in connection with the scholarship unless they request otherwise.

## General Conditions



The scholarship is not transferable and must be used for the 2026 Forum only.  
Anmac reserves the right to:

- Amend these terms if required
- Make final decisions on all aspects of the scholarship.
