The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Accreditation Council (ANMAC) is seeking Expressions of Interest from experienced nursing and midwifery academics to chair one of the four accreditation committees:

- Registered Nurse Accreditation Committee
- Midwife Accreditation Committee
- Enrolled Nurse Accreditation Committee
- Nurse Practitioner Accreditation Committee

ANMAC is the independent accrediting authority for nursing and midwifery education under Australia's National Registration and Accreditation Scheme. ANMAC helps protect the health and safety of the Australian community by establishing high-quality standards of nursing and midwifery education, training and assessment. ANMAC is responsible for facilitating the development of accreditation standards in consultation with our stakeholders. ANMAC is also responsible for determining whether programs of study leading to registration as a nurse or midwife in Australia meet the required accreditation standards.

ANMAC's Skilled Migration Services team is responsible for assessing the skills of nurses and midwives who want to migrate to Australia under the General Skilled Migration program.

The general skills required of the Chair:

- Extensive and demonstrable experience in a leadership role of an Australian Nursing and or Midwifery education program
- Demonstrated knowledge of the accreditation functions performed by ANMAC
- Proven experience, knowledge and application of the relevant Accreditation standards to nursing and midwifery programs.
- Substantial experience and knowledge of university and or VET Sector administrative processes and structures
- Experience in chairing committees, panels or boards in the academic, educational or not-for-profit sectors
- Extensive knowledge of committee process and procedures
- Ability to synthesise complex information and build consensus in a group setting
